BARDEN LANE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Barden Lane, Burnley from its junction with Lower Manor Lane to its junction with Blacker Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 16th February 2026 until 1700 hours on Monday 23rd March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Barden Lane - Windermere Avenue - A682 Colne Road - Railway Street –
B6248 Cuckstool Lane – A6068 Barrowford Road - Greenhead Lane - Barden
Lane -Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow bridge repairs to damaged bridge works to be carried out.
