

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(A570 KNOWSLEY ROAD, ORMSKIRK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of A570 Knowsley Road, Ormskirk from its junction with A570 St Helens Road for a distance of 30 metres in a northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1900 to 2300 hours on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
A570 St Helens Road, A570 Moor Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow manhole frame and cover replacement works to be carried out.
