(REAR 53–63 BURNLEY ROAD, BRIERFIELD, PENDLE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 53–63 Burnley Road, Brierfield from a point at the rear of 1 Massey Street travelling in a westerly direction for approximately 15 metres.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 10:30 hours on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2026 until 23:59 hours on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion is not required at this location.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent utility works to take place.
