

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS LOCATIONS, CHORLEY, HYNDBURN, PRESTON,
ROSSENDALE, SOUTH RIBBLE, WEST LANCASHIRE) (REVOCATION
AND VARIOUS SPEED LIMITS (25-26 NO3)) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Speed Limit Order under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the following:

- a) "The Lancashire County Council (Bannister Lane, Bannister Green And Wrennall's Lane, Eccleston And Heskin, Chorley Borough) (Restricted Roads) Order, 1994" insofar as it relates to Item 3 of the Schedule.
- b) The "Lancashire County Council (West Baxenden Area, Accrington (Various Roads),Hyndburn Borough) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2013" insofar as it relates to Hollins Lane in the Schedule.
- c) The "Lancashire County Council (Woodnook Area, Accrington (Various Roads) Hyndburn Borough) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2014" insofar as it relates to Hollins Lane in the Schedule.
- d) "The Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Bretherton, Chorley Borough)(Revocation And Restricted Roads) Order 1997" insofar as it relates to Item 2 in the Schedule.
- e) "The South Ribble Borough Council (Stanifield Lane And Lydiate Lane, Farington)(30mph Speed Limit) Order 2001" insofar as it relates to the following:
 - i. a 30mph speed limit on Lydiate Lane, from the extended eastern kerbline of Stanifield Lane for a distance of 300 metres south-eastwards along Lydiate Lane;
 - ii. a 30mph speed limit on Stanifield Lane, from the current start of the 30 mph speed restriction on Stanifield Lane situated 40m south of the produced southern kerbline of Lydiate Lane to a point 10 metres south of the extended southern kerbline of Fowler Lane.
- f) "The Lancashire County Council (Smithy Lane, Brindle, Chorley Borough)(Restricted Road) Order 1994" in full.
- g) "The Lancashire County Council (Ulnes Walton Lane, Ulnes Walton, Chorley Borough)(Revocation And Restricted Road) Order 1999" in full.
- h) "The Lancashire County Council (School Lane, And Ulnes Walton Lane, Leyland South Ribble Borough)(30mph Speed Limit)(No.2) Order 1987" in full.
- i) The "Lancashire County Council (Bilsborrow Lane and Various Roads, Inglewhite, Preston Borough) (Restricted Roads) Order, 1999" in full.

2. Introduce a 20mph speed limit on the following lengths of road:

- a) Hollins Lane, Accrington, the entire length;
- b) Vicarage Lane, Banks, the entire length.

3. Introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following lengths of road:

- a) Bilsborrow Lane, Preston, from its junction with Carron Lane for a distance of 80 metres in a westerly direction;
- b) Button Street, Preston, from its junctions with Carron Lane/Inglewhite Road to a point 315.5 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Fairhurst Lane;
- c) Carron Lane, Preston, the entire length;
- d) Eyes Lane, Bretherton, from its junction with South Road for a distance of 113 metres in a southerly direction;
- e) Inglewhite Road, Preston, from its junction with Carron Lane for a distance of 423.5 metres in an easterly direction;
- f) Roundhill Lane, Haslingden, from its junction with Roundhill Road for a distance of 525 metres in a north easterly direction;
- g) Silk Mill Lane, Preston, from its junctions with Bilsborrow Lane and Carron Lane for a distance of 457 metres in a southerly direction;
- h) Smithy Lane, Brindle, from its junction with Sandy Lane for a distance of 196 metres in a north westerly direction;

- i) South Road, Bretherton, from its junction with Eyes Lane for a distance of 74 metres in a north westerly direction;
- j) Ulnes Walton Lane, Ulnes Walton, from its junction with Ulnes Walton Lane, Moss Side for a distance of 245 metres in a southerly direction;
- k) Ulnes Walton Lane, Moss Side, from a point 20 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Hedgerows Road to its junction with Ulnes Walton Lane, Ulnes Walton;
- l) Wrennalls Lane, Heskin, from its junction with Bannister Green for a distance of 231 metres in a south westerly direction.

4. Introduce a 40mph speed limit on Moor Lane, Haslingden, the entire length.
