(SCHOOL LANE, AND ULNES WALTON LANE, LEYLAND  
SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)  
(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 2) ORDER 1987

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Lancashire in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. It is directed that no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (School Lane, and Ulnes Walton Lane, Leyland, South Ribble Borough) (30 mph Speed Limit) (No. 2.) Order 1987", and shall come into operation on the 22nd May, 1987.

THE COMMON SEAL of the Lancashire County Council was hereunto affixed in pursuance of a Resolution passed at a meeting of the Highways and Transportation Committee duly convened and held on the 21st January, 1987.

SCHEDULE

Length of Road at Leyland, South Ribble Borough

1. That length of School Lane from its junction with Dunkirk Lane in a southerly direction to its junction with Ulnes Walton Lane, a distance of approximately 440m.
2. That length of Ulnes Walton Lane from its junction with School Lane for a distance of approximately 95m in a southerly direction.
