



**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(ULNES WALTON LANE, ULNES WALTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH)  
(REVOCATION AND RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER, 1999.**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Croston, Eccleston, Euxton, Ulnes Walton and Leyland, Chorley and South Ribble Boroughs) (40mph Speed Limits) Order, 1994, is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to the length of Ulnes Walton Lane specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Ulnes Walton Lane, Ulnes Walton, Chorley Borough) (Revocation and Restricted Road) Order 1999 and shall come into force on the 5<sup>th</sup> April, 1999.

THE COMMON SEAL of the Lancashire County Council was hereunto affixed in pursuance of a Resolution passed at a meeting of the Highways and Transportation Committee duly convened and held on the 11th March, 1998.
