
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Southfield Lane, Southfield from its junction with delves Lane to outside Shelfield Farm.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1600 hours on Monday 23rd March 2026 until Tuesday 24th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Knotts Lane – Bridge Street – Primet Hill – Primet Bridge – Burnley Road – Leeds Road – Barkerhouse Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the installation of Openreach Telecom poles to be carried out.
