


**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(CHARLES STREET, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)**  
**(ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 202\***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 13 June 2025 and 11 July 2025, it is now intended abandon the proposal.

### Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this scheme is to support the improved amenity in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson.

Following formal consultation and in response to feedback received, the proposal to introduce a one way on Charles Street is no longer being pursued.
