


NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(SCOTLAND ROAD, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH) (BUS STOP
CLEARWAYS)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to introduce the above Bus Stop Clearways. Following consultation carried out between 13/06/2025 and 11/07/2025, it is now intended to modify the proposal as titled above, as set out below.

1. Remove the previously proposed bus stop clearway Scotland Road, Nelson, the north east side, from a point 7 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Charles Street for a distance of 18.5 metres in a north westerly direction.
2. Introduce a bus stop clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in Scotland Road, the north east side, from a point 25.5 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Charles Street for a distance of 18 metres in a north westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this scheme is to support the improved amenity in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson.

Following the conclusion of the formal consultation process, and in consideration of the feedback received, a decision has been made to amend the proposed Bus Stop Clearway on the north east side of Scotland Road. The amendment entails relocating the existing bus stop 18 metres further to the north west.

This adjustment is intended to enhance visibility for vehicles emerging from Charles Street onto Scotland Road, in light of the recent decision to reinstate two way traffic flow on Charles Street.
