


NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CHARLES STREET, LEEDS ROAD AND NEW SCOTLAND ROAD,
NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH) (REVOCATION AND PROHIBITION
OF WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 10 October 2025 and 07 November 2025, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

Abandon the prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- Charles Street, Nelson, the north west side, from a point 40 metres north east of its junction with the Centreline of Fleet Street for a distance of 6.5 metres in a north easterly direction;
- Charles Street, Nelson, the south east side, from a point 26 metres north east of its junction with the Centreline of Fleet Street for a distance of 17 metres in a north easterly direction.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this scheme is to support the improved amenity in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson.

Following formal consultation and in response to feedback received it is proposed to make a modification to remove the proposed No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on Charles Street.
