(RAILWAY STREET, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY ONE – WAY PROHIBITION ORDER) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Railway Street, Nelson travelling in a north bound direction from its junction with Netherfield Road to its junction with Broadway.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 07:00 hours on Friday 27th February 2026 until 2359 hours Wednesday 3rd March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion for traffic affected by this prohibition is as follows: -

Netherfield Road - Sagar Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to reduce congestion on site and improve traffic flows for Buses exiting the bus station.
