

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BETT LANE, HIGHER WHEELTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(REVOCATION AND PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Chorley Borough) (Revocation And Various Parking Restrictions (24-25 NO1G)) Order 2025" insofar as it relates to Items b) and c) of Schedule 2.
2. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in Bett Lane, Higher Wheelton, the south side, from its junction with the Centreline of Blackburn Road for a distance of 89 metres in a south easterly direction.
