


**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 65(1) and 66(4) of the Highways Act 1980 Lancashire County Council propose to convert the following lengths of footway to joint use cycleways:-

- a) Barton Road, from its junction with the centreline of Bowerham Road, for a distance of 30m in a southerly direction;
- b) Bowerham Road, from its junction with the centreline of Barton Road, for a distance of 393m in a general southerly direction.



### Statement of Reasons

This is a confirmation under the highways act in support of what is already in place on site. No TRO is required and there are no changes to the arrangements on site. The shared use cycle-way allows both pedestrians and cyclists to use this designated route for passage, to promote inclusivity for all road users and to enhance safety and accessibility.
