ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HAYDOCKS LANE AREA ZONE, COTTAM, PRESTON CITY)
(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2002**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. For the purpose of this Order "Haydocks Lane Area Zone Boundary" means the Boundary as defined in Schedule 2 to this Order.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order and situated inside the Haydocks Lane Area Zone Boundary.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Haydocks Lane Area Zone, Cottam, Preston City) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2002 and shall come into force on the 9th September 2002.

Schedule 1 20mph speed limit on the following lengths of roads within the Haydocks Lane Area Zone Boundary (full length unless otherwise stated):-

- Millersgate
- The Gables
- Valentines Meadow
- The Evergreens
- Spires Grove
- Minster Park
- Crosier Walk
- Rosedene Close
- Rosewood
- Roseberry Avenue
- Haydocks Lane (from Merry Trees Lane to its junction with the unnamed access road to Keats Way)

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Schedule 2 Description of the Haydocks Lane Area Zone Boundary:-

- 1) From Point A along a straight line to Point B. Point A is where the western highway boundary of Haydocks Lane meets the southern highway boundary of The Weald. Point B is where the eastern highway boundary of Haydocks Lane meets the south-eastern highway boundary of Merry Trees Lane.
- 2) From Point B along the south-eastern highway boundary of Merry Trees Lane in a north-easterly direction to Point C. Point C is where the south-eastern highway boundary of Merry Trees Lane meets the eastern highway boundary of Minster Park.
- 3) From Point C along a straight line in an easterly direction to Point D. Point D is where the south-eastern highway boundary of Merry Trees Lane meets the south-eastern highway boundary of Roseberry Avenue.
- 4) From Point D along the south-eastern highway boundary of Merry Trees Lane for 150 metres in a north-easterly direction to Point E. Point E is on the south-eastern highway boundary of Merry Trees Lane 75 metres north-east of the extended centre line of The Villas.
- 5) From Point E along a straight line in a southerly direction to Point F. Point F is where the western highway boundary of Tom Benson Way meets the northern highway boundary of Cottam Way.
- 6) From Point F along the north/north-easterly highway boundary of Cottam Way in a north-westerly direction to Point G. Point G is where the north-easterly highway boundary of Cottam Way meets the north-westerly highway boundary of Valentines Meadow.
- 7) From Point G along a straight line in a north-westerly direction to Point H. Point H is where the western highway boundary of Haydocks Lane meets the northern highway boundary of the unnamed access road to Keats Way.
- 8) From Point H along the western highway boundary of Haydocks Lane in a northerly direction to Point A.
