

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(LIGHTFOOT LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)**  
**(REMOVAL AND INTRODUCTION OF BUS STOP**  
**CLEARWAY)**



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

1. Remove a bus stop in the following locations:
  - a) Lightfoot Lane, Preston, the north side, from a point 77.7 metres west of its junction with the centreline of The Maples;
  - b) Lightfoot Lane, Preston, the south side, from a point 116.8 metres east of its junction with the centreline of The Maples.
2. Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
  - a) Lightfoot Lane, Preston, the north side, from a point 125.7 metres west of its junction with the centreline of The Maples for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction
  - b) Lightfoot Lane, Preston, the south side, from a point 142.1 metres west of its junction with the centreline of The Maples for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction.

**Statement of Reasons**

It is proposed to relocate the existing East and West bound bus stops to new locations further west on Lightfoot Lane Preston, with enforceable clearway markings and signs allowing buses to pull in safely and efficiently at the stop.

The proposal intends to promote sustainable transport for all users by including the construction of a raised platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
