
(CLANCUTT LANE, CLAYTON GATE, COPPULL, CHORLEY BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
  - I. Clancutt Lane, Coppull from its junction with The Heys, Coppull for a distance of 40 metres in a southeast direction.
  - II. Clayton Gate, Coppull from its junction with Spendmore Lane, Coppull for a distance of 30 metres in a southeast direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
  - I. Clancutt Lane - B5251 Spendmore Lane – The Heys and Vice Versa.
  - II. Clayton Gate – Chapel Lane – Spendmore Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
