(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Deardengate, Haslingden from its junction with Hindle Street to its junction with Bank Street.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative 1130 hours on Tuesday 10th March 2026 until 1800 hours on Friday 13th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the completion of public realm works to be carried out by Bethell Construction on behalf of Rossendale Borough Council.
