

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(THE FIELDS/BEECHFIELDS INCLUDING DRAPER AVENUE AREA  
ZONE, ECCLESTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH)  
(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2008**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. For the purpose of this Order 'The Fields/Beechfields including Draper Avenue Area Zone Boundary' means the Boundary as defined in Schedule 2 to this Order.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order and situated inside The Fields/Beechfields including Draper Avenue Area Zone Boundary.
3. This Order may be cited as 'The Lancashire County Council (The Fields/Beechfields including Draper Avenue, Eccleston, Chorley Borough) (20MPH Speed Limit) Order 2008 and shall come into force on the 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2008

**Schedule 1** 20mph speed limit on the following lengths of roads within The Fields/Beechfields including Draper Avenue Area Zone Boundary (full length unless otherwise stated):-

**Schedule 2** Description of The Fields/Beechfields including Draper Avenue Area Zone Boundary:-

From point A for a distance of 220 metres in a southeasterly direction to point B.

Point A - the southern boundary of Tincklers Lane at its junction with the western boundary of Towngate.

Point B - the northeast boundary of The Fields at a point coinciding with boundary between No's 52 and 54 The Fields.

From point B for a distance of 85 metres in an easterly direction to the north-west boundary of the eastern most part of The Fields (boundary between No's 18 and 20 The Fields), then for a distance of 90 metres in an easterly direction to point C.

Point C - the northern boundary of The Fields at its junction with the western boundary of The Green.

From point C for a distance of 100 metres in a southerly direction to point D.

Point D - the western point of Greenway at a point coinciding with the boundary between No's 10 and 11 Greenway.

From point D for a distance of 20 metres south along the western boundary of Greenway and then 95 metres in a southeasterly direction to point E.

Point E - The western boundary of The Green at its junction with the northern boundary of Doctors Lane.

From point E for a distance of 365 metres in a southeasterly direction along the southwestern boundary of The Green to point F.

Point F - the southern boundary of Red House Lane at its junction with the western boundary of The Green.

From Point F for a distance of 295 metres in a southwesterly direction to point G.

Point G – the southern most point of Larkfield

From point G for a distance of 320 metres in a northwesterly direction to point H.

Point H – the southern boundary of Snipewood coinciding with the southern boundary of number 54 Snipewood.

From point H for a distance of 145 metres in a northwesterly direction to point I.

Point I - the western boundary of Reeveswood coinciding with the boundary between No's 15a and 16 Reeveswood.

From Point I for a distance of 245 metres in a northerly direction to point J.

Point J - the western boundary of Chaucer Close coinciding with the boundary between No's 28 and 29 Chaucer Close.

From point J for a distance of 120 metres in a north easterly direction to point K

Point K the Northern boundary of Doctors Lane coinciding with the western boundary of Cricketers Green.

From point K for a distance of 185 metres in a northwesterly direction to point L.

Point L - the northern point of Banner Close coinciding with the boundary between No's 12 and 14 Banner Close


From Point L for a distance of 180 metres in a northerly direction to point M.

Point M - the western point of the Hawthorns adjacent to the northern boundary of 111 The Hawthorns.

From point M for a distance of 230 metres in a north easterly direction to point A.
