

Stocks Massey Music Library

Burnley Central Library is proud to announce that the newly renovated Stocks Massey Music Library is now open to the public.

After securing £165,000 from the UK Government's Cultural Investment Fund (via DCMS/ Arts Council England) and further funding from the Edwards Stocks Massey Bequest and Lancashire County Council, Burnley Library was able to refurbish the former Children's Library into the Stocks Massey Music Library.

Located on the top floor of Burnley Central Library, the space houses the Stocks Massey sheet music and scores collection, alongside a variety of music texts and musician biographies. There is also a beautiful exhibition of musical instruments and objects that have been generously loaned by the Lancashire Museum Service, that will run until August 2026.

The room will also be used to host a variety of events including concerts, workshops, and other activities arranged by local groups, artists and musical educators and other cultural partners.

This is a full day choral experience inclusive of musical tuition by our expert choral director Marc Murray, hire of the score, refreshments and a delicious buffet style lunch. 
