


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(MARKET STREET, EDENFIELD, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH)
(PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a puffin crossing in Market Street, Edenfield, from a point 41.96 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Guide Court for a distance of 41 metres in a southerly direction.



Statement of Reasons

This proposal introduces a puffin crossing on Market Street, Edenfield between the proposed development on the west side of Market Street and Edenfield Primary School on the eastern side.

The purpose of this proposal is to help improve safety, support active travel and provide a convenient, accessible and safe crossing point for pedestrians and vulnerable users; and particularly for those accessing the school.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a Section 278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development on the West side of Blackburn Road to improve pedestrian links to the east side of Market Street.
