THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF LANGASHIRE (HASLINGDEN TRAFFIC  
REGULATION) ORDER, 1952.

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them under or by virtue of sub-section (2) of Section 46 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and Section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933, hereby make the following Order :-

- (1) No person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle on the roads specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto otherwise than in the direction specified in the second column of the said Schedule.
- (2) The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies for the purpose of the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (3) This Order may be cited as "The County Council of Lancashire (Haslingden Traffic Regulation) Order, 1952".

SCHEDULE

1

Regent Street, Class III, and Union Street, Haslingden, from the junction with Blackburn Road to the junction with John Street in each case.
