

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(DEARDENGATE AREA, HASLINGDEN, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH) (REVOCATION, PROHIBITION
OF DRIVING AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and 92 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the following:
 - a) "The County Council Of Lancashire (Haslingden Traffic Regulation) Order 1952" in full.
 - b) "The Lancashire County Council (Haslingden Borough Roads Restriction) Order 1953" in full.
2. Introduce a prohibition of driving except cycles and access in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Deardengate, Haslingden, from its junction with Bank Street to its junction with Bury Road in a northerly direction;
 - b) Ratcliffe Fold, Haslingden, from its junction with Deardengate to its junction with Bell Street in a westerly direction.

This prohibition includes provision for an obstruction to be placed in accordance with Section 92 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
3. Introduce a one way traffic restriction in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Bank Street, Haslingden, from its junction with Deardengate for a distance of 43 metres, west to east;
 - b) Deardengate, Haslingden, from its junction with Pleasant Street to its junction with Bank Street, south to north;
 - c) Hindle Street, Haslingden, from its junction with Deardengate for its entire length, west to east;
 - d) John Street, Haslingden, from its junction with Regent Street to its junction with Union Street, north to south.
