Comments	<p>At the September Parish Council meeting, held Tuesday 12th September 2023, application LCC/2023/0030 was discussed and the Parish Council strongly objected to this proposal.</p> <p>It is disappointing that Stalmine with Staynall Parish Council was not asked for comments. As a Parish Council we feel we have valid concerns for the objection to this development.</p> <p>The Parish Council believe there will be a significant negative impact on the village should this development go ahead, so feel compelled to comment.</p> <p>Many Stalmine with Staynall residents have contacted councillors with their concerns and all the Parish Councillors share these concerns. The development will see a significant increase in HGV traffic on the road through the village, passing the local Primary School which is also on the main road. Twice per day during school times the main road through the village parents have to park their vehicles on the main road. This causes significant blocks of the main road as the road becomes impassable to side by side traffic. This causes significant risk to the children and parents of Stalmine Primary School, whilst causing significant delays and the back up of traffic levels. The additional HGV traffic this development will create poses a significant risk to this area of Stalmine. We feel that the latest traffic management plan does not address this issue. Levels of pollution and noise from these vehicles will have a negative impact on the residents.</p> <p>Stalmine with Staynall Parish Council strongly object to this development, whilst we appreciate the need for aggregate extraction we feel other areas that do not impact the villages of Wyre should be explored and developed.</p>
