(GILBERT WAY AND RIVERSLEIGH WAY, BRYNING WITH WARTON, FYLDE BOROUGH)
(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 12th March 2026 Lancashire County Council made the above Speed Limit Order under Section 84 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit in the following lengths of road:

- a) Gilbert Way, Bryning with Warton, the entire length;
- b) Riversleigh Way, Bryning with Warton, the entire length

This Order will come into force on the 30th March 2026.
