(DAUB HALL LANE, WALTON-LE-DALE, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026


**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Daub Hall Lane, Walton Le Dale from its junction with A675 Hoghton Lane, Higher Walton for a distance of 65 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Daub Hall Lane – Bells Lane - A675 Hoghton Lane – Gregson Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to carry out Trial Holes to determine the location of services in advance of planned works as part of the United Utilities Better Rivers programme of works.
