
(BACK LEYLAND LANE 374 TO 346, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Back Leyland Lane 374 To 346, Leyland from its junction with B5248 Slater Lane, Leyland for a distance of 39 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2026 until 1630 hours on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not applicable.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out for a new service connection.
