

## **NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER**

#### **THE DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY FOR THE COUNTY OF LANCASHIRE**

#### **THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY PUBLIC FOOTPATHS AT BANKS ENCLOSED MARSH, NORTH MEOLS, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH (DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION) ORDER 2014**

The above Order, made on the 18<sup>th</sup> December 2014, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by adding 5 public footpaths as described below:

1. A 3 metre wide public footpath from the junction of Georges Lane and public bridleways 48 & 49 North Meols (Point A on the Order plan) (SD 3885 2189) running in a north westerly direction to Point D ending at the junction with public footpaths 38 & 39 North Meols (SD 3852 2236), for a total distance of approximately 570 metres.
2. A 3 metre wide public footpath from the junction of Charnleys Lane and public bridleways 47 & 48 North Meols (Point F) (SD3835 2156) running in a north westerly direction to Point I (SD 3803 2201) for a total distance of approximately 570 metres.
3. A 3 metre wide public footpath starting from the junction with public bridleway 47 North Meols (Point J) (SD 3796 2119) running in a northerly direction to Point K, the path then continues in a generally south westerly direction and ends at Point O on the Order plan at its junction with public footpath 40 North Meols (SD 3730 2088) for a total distance of approximately 770 metres.
4. A 3 metre wide public footpath starting from the junction of the farm tracks at Point K on the Order plan (SD 3796 2121) continuing in a north westerly direction to Point R (SD 3760 2171) for a total distance of approximately 635 metres.
5. A 1.5 metre wide public footpath starting at the junction with public bridleway 48 North Meols, close to Cross Bank Cottage, (Point S on the Order plan) (SD 3856 2176), continuing in a north westerly direction to Point V (SD 3827 2218) for a total distance of approximately 520 metres.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, Lancashire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

3.A 3 metre wide public footpath starting from the junction with public bridleway 47 North Meols (Point J) (SD 3796 2119) running in a northerly direction to Point K, the path then continues in a generally south westerly direction and ends at Point O on the Order plan at its junction with public footpath 40 North Meols (SD 3730 2088) for a total distance of approximately 770 metres.

4.A 3 metre wide public footpath starting from the junction of the farm tracks at Point K on the Order plan (SD 3796 2121) continuing in a north westerly direction to Point R (SD 3760 2171) for a total distance of approximately 635 metres.

5.A 1.5 metre wide public footpath starting at the junction with public bridleway 48 North Meols, close to Cross Bank Cottage, (Point S on the Order plan) (SD 3856 2176), continuing in a north westerly direction to Point V (SD 3827 2218) for a total distance of approximately 520 metres.
