

NOTICE OF MAKING
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LANGTHWAITE BROW AND WYRESDALE ROAD, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY)
(REVOCAION AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 09 April 2026 Lancashire County Council made the above Speed Limit Order under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Lancaster, Pendle and Ribble Valley Boroughs) (Revocation, 20mph, 30mph, 40mph and 50mph Speed Limits) Order 2019" insofar as it relates to Item (b) of Schedule 4.
2. Introduce a 40mph speed limit in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Langthwaite Brow, Lancaster, from its junction with Wyresdale Road for a distance of 72 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - b) Wyresdale Road, Lancaster, from a point 96.5 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Grab Lane to its junction with Langthwaite Brow.

This Order will come into force on the 27th April 2026.
