

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967


THE CITY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER (RESTRICTED ROADS)

(NO.1) ORDER 1981

The City Council of Lancaster (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 72(3), 73(1), 74(1) and 74(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84(C)(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby order and direct as follows :-

1. That the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, which are not restricted roads for the purpose of Section 71 of the Act of 1967 shall, in accordance with Section 74 of the Act of 1967, become subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h.
2. That the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purpose of Section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.
3. This Order may be cited as "The City Council of Lancaster (Restricted Roads) (No.1) Order 1981" and shall come into operation on 1st October, 1981.

SCHEDULE 1

1. That length of the B.5273 Oxcliffe Road, in Morecambe and Heaton-with-Oxcliffe, which extends from a point 460 metres east of the junction with Woodlands Drive to the junction with White Lund Road.

2. That length of the B.5273 Mellishaw Lane, Heaton-with-Oxcliffe, which extends from its junction with White Lund Road for a distance of 110 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

That length of the B.5273 Oxcliffe Road, Morecambe, which extends from a point 90 metres east of the junction with Woodlands Drive for a distance of 370 metres in an easterly direction.
