THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(RESTRICTED ROADS) (NO. 4) ORDER 1984

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the "Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for Lancashire in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. The 30 mph speed limit imposed on that length of the B6254 Market Street East/Kellett Road, Carnforth, from its junction with A6 Scotland Road to a point 13 metres east of its junction with Russell Road by virtue of Section 82(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, shall cease to have effect.
2. It is directed that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purpose of Section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
3. This Order shall be cited as 'The Lancashire County Council (Restricted Roads) (No. 4) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on the 12th November, 1984.

SCHEDULE

Length of road at Carnforth, in the District of Lancaster

That length of the B6254 Market Street East/Kellett Road, from its junction with A6 Scotland Road, to a point 48 metres east of its junction with Back Lane, a total distance of approximately 895 metres.
