**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
MOSS LANE (ALSO KNOWN AS STRAIGHT UP LANE) AND WYKE LANE, NORTH MEOLS,
WEST LANCASHIRE DISTRICT - RESTRICTED ROADS ORDER, 1997.**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council Moss Lane (also known as Straight Up Lane) and Wyke Lane, North Meols, West Lancashire District - Restricted Roads Order 1997 and shall come into force on the 16th May, 1997.

THE COMMON SEAL of the Lancashire County Council was hereunto affixed in pursuance of a Resolution passed at a meeting of the Highways and Transportation Committee duly convened and held on the 30th August, 1995.

SCHEDULE

1. Moss Lane, from the centre line of Wyke Lane for a distance of approximately 75 metres in a westerly direction to the County Boundary with Sefton Metropolitan Borough on the west side of the Three Pools Waterway.
2. Moss Lane (also known as Straight Up Lane), from its junction with Wyke Lane for a distance of 86 metres in an easterly direction.
3. Wyke Lane, from its junction with Moss Lane for a distance of 176 metres in a southerly direction.
