

# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (PART REVOCATION, RESTRICTED ROAD 30MPH, 30MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 83(2) and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

### **1. Part Revocations**

- a) That part of the "Lancashire County Council (B5246 The Marshes Lane/ Holmeswood Road, Mere Brow/ Holmeswood and A5147 Halsall Road/Gorsuch Lane, Halsall/Gorsuch West Lancashire Borough)(Part Revocation, 30 40 and 50 mph speed limit) Order 2011" as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order;
- b) That part of the "Lancashire County Council (Higher Lane, Beacon Lane and Hillock Lane, Dalton West Lancashire Borough)(Restricted Road and 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2012" as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order;
- c) That part of the "Lancashire County Council Various Roads Rufford and Tarleton, West Lancashire District)(30 mph and 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1990" as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order;
- d) That part of the "Lancashire County Council (Bescar Lane, Bescar, West Lancashire District)(40 mph speed limit) Order 1989" as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order;
- e) That part of the "Lancashire County Council Various Streets, West Lancashire District)(30 mph Speed Limit and 40 mph Speed Limit (No.2) Order 1988" as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.

### **2. Restricted Road (30mph Speed Limit will apply)**

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road which shall become restricted roads (as defined in section 82 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984) as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

### **3. 30mph Speed Limit**

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along those lengths of road as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

### **4. 40mph Speed Limit**

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along those lengths of road as specified in Schedule 4 to this Order

### **5. Exemption**


No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

## 6. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, West Lancashire Borough) (Part Revocation, Restricted Road 30mph, 30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2017" and shall come into force on the 24th day of March 2017".

### Schedule 1 - Part Revocations

- a) Articles 1 and 3 of the "Lancashire County Council (B5246 The Marshes Lane/ Holmeswood Road, Mere Brow/ Holmeswood and A5147 Halsall Road/Gorsuch Lane, Halsall/Gorsuch West Lancashire Borough)(Part Revocation, 30 40 and 50 mph speed limit) Order 2011"
- b) Article 2 of the "Lancashire County Council (Higher Lane, Beacon Lane and Hillock Lane, Dalton West Lancashire Borough) (Restricted Road and 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2012" insofar as it relates to item 1 of Schedule 2 to that Order.
- c) Article 2 of the "Lancashire County Council Various Roads Rufford and Tarleton, West Lancashire District) (30 mph and 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1990" insofar as it relates to item 3 of Schedule 2 to that Order.
- d) Article 1 of the "Lancashire County Council (Bescar Lane, Bescar, West Lancashire District) (40 mph speed limit) Order 1989" insofar as it relates to item 1 of the Schedule to that Order.
- e) That part of the "Lancashire County Council Various Streets, West Lancashire District)(30 mph Speed Limit and 40 mph Speed Limit (No.2) Order 1988" insofar as it relates to items 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 to that Order.

### Schedule 2 - Restricted Roads (30mph speed limit)

- a) B5246 Holmeswood Road, Holmeswood, from a point 164 metres south east of the centreline of Sandy Lane in a north-westerly direction to its junction with The Marshes Lane.
- b) Wiggins Lane, Holmeswood, from its junction with B5246 Holmeswood Road for a distance of 336 metres in a south westerly direction.
- c) Lyelake Lane (Service Road) Bickerstaffe for its entire length from its junction with Lyelake Lane main carriageway to its junction with Skelmersdale Road main carriageway, a total of 128 metres.
- d) B5312 Skelmersdale Road, Bickerstaffe from its junction with the roundabout junction for a distance of 280 metres in a north easterly direction.
- e) Barrow Nook Lane Bickerstaffe, from a point 50 metres north-west of its junction with Coach Road to the centre line of Moss Lane.

- f) Coach Road Bickerstaffe from its junction with Barrow Nook Lane to a point 50 metres south-east of the centre line of Moss Lane.
- g) Moss Lane, Bickerstaffe for its entire length from its junction with Coach Road to its junction with Sinacre Lane.
- h) Sinacre Lane, Bickerstaffe from its junction with Barrow Nook Lane to a point 150 metres south of its junction with Moss Lane.
- i) Bescar Lane, Scarisbrick, from a point 250 metres south of the centre line of Drummersdale Lane to a point 460 metres north east of the centre line of Drummersdale Lane.
- j) Drummersdale Lane, Scarisbrick from the centre line of Bescar Lane for a distance of 300 metres in an easterly direction.
- k) Swan Close, Scarisbrick for its entire length.
- l) Wood Moss Lane, Scarisbrick from the centre line of Bescar Lane for a distance of 330 metres in a north westerly direction.
- m) Daisy Lane, Lathom for its entire length.
- n) Meadow Lane, Lathom from a point 8 metres north of its junction with Bleak Lane to a point 65 metres south of its junction with Daisy Lane.
- o) Higher Lane, Dalton from a point 90 metres south of its junction with Ash Brow to a point 420 metres south of its junction with Ash Brow.

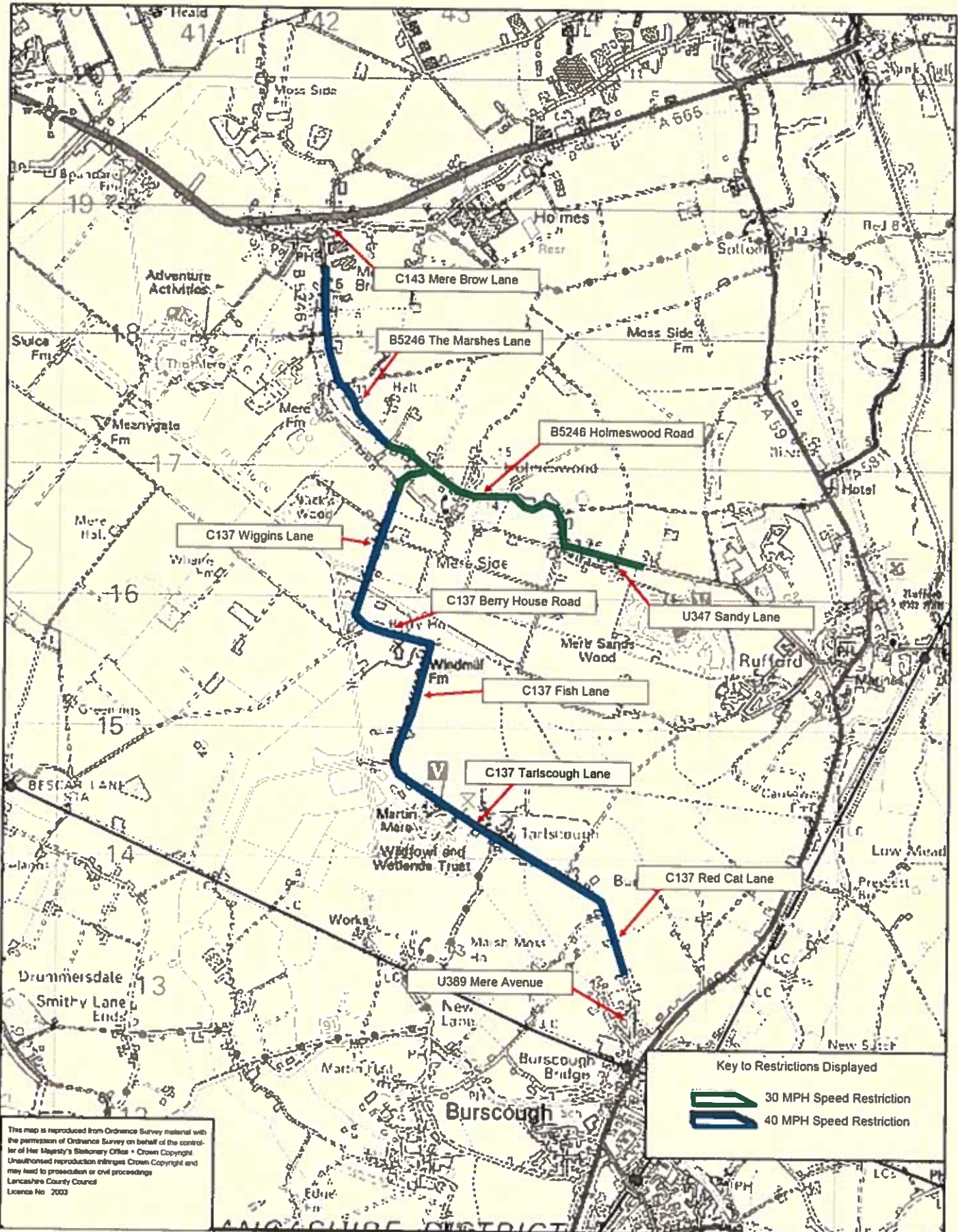
**Schedule 3 – Introduce a 30mph speed limit**

- a) Elmer's Green Lane, Skelmersdale from the centre line of Beacons Lane for a distance of 585 metres in a southerly direction.
- b) Bleak Lane, Lathom from its junction with Meadow Lane for a distance of 175 metres in a north easterly direction.
- c) Meadow Lane, Lathom from a point 65 metres south of its junction with Daisy Lane for a distance of 110 metres in a southerly direction.
- d) Meadow Lane, Lathom from a point 8 metres north of its junction with Bleak Lane for a distance of 167 metres in a northerly direction.

**Schedule 4 - Introduce a 40mph speed limit**


- a) B5312 Liverpool Road, Skelmersdale from the centre line of Skelmersdale Road for a distance of 80 metres north and then east.
- b) White Moss Road, Skelmersdale from the centre line of Liverpool Road for a distance of 475 metres in a south easterly direction.
- c) B5312 Skelmersdale Road Bickerstaffe from a point 280 metres north east of its junction with the roundabout with Leylake Lane to its junction with Liverpool Road.
- d) B5264 The Marshes Lane, Tarleton, from its junction with B5246 Holmeswood Road to a point 271 metres south of the centre line of Mere Brow Lane.
- e) Wiggins Lane, Rufford from a point 336 metres south west of the centre line of Holmeswood Road to its junction with Berry House Road.
- f) Berry House Road, Scarisbrick for its entire length.


- g) Fish Lane, Burscough for its entire length.
- h) Tarlscough Lane, Burscough, for its entire length.
- i) Red Cat Lane, from its junction with Tarlscough Lane in an easterly and south easterly direction to a point 326 metres north of the centreline of Mere Avenue.
- j) Bescar Lane, Scarisbrick, from a point 250 metres south of its junction with Drummersdale Lane for a distance of 520 metres in a southerly direction.
- k) Higher Lane, Dalton from a point 420 metres south of its junction with Ash Brow to a point 160 metres south of its junction with Hillock Lane.

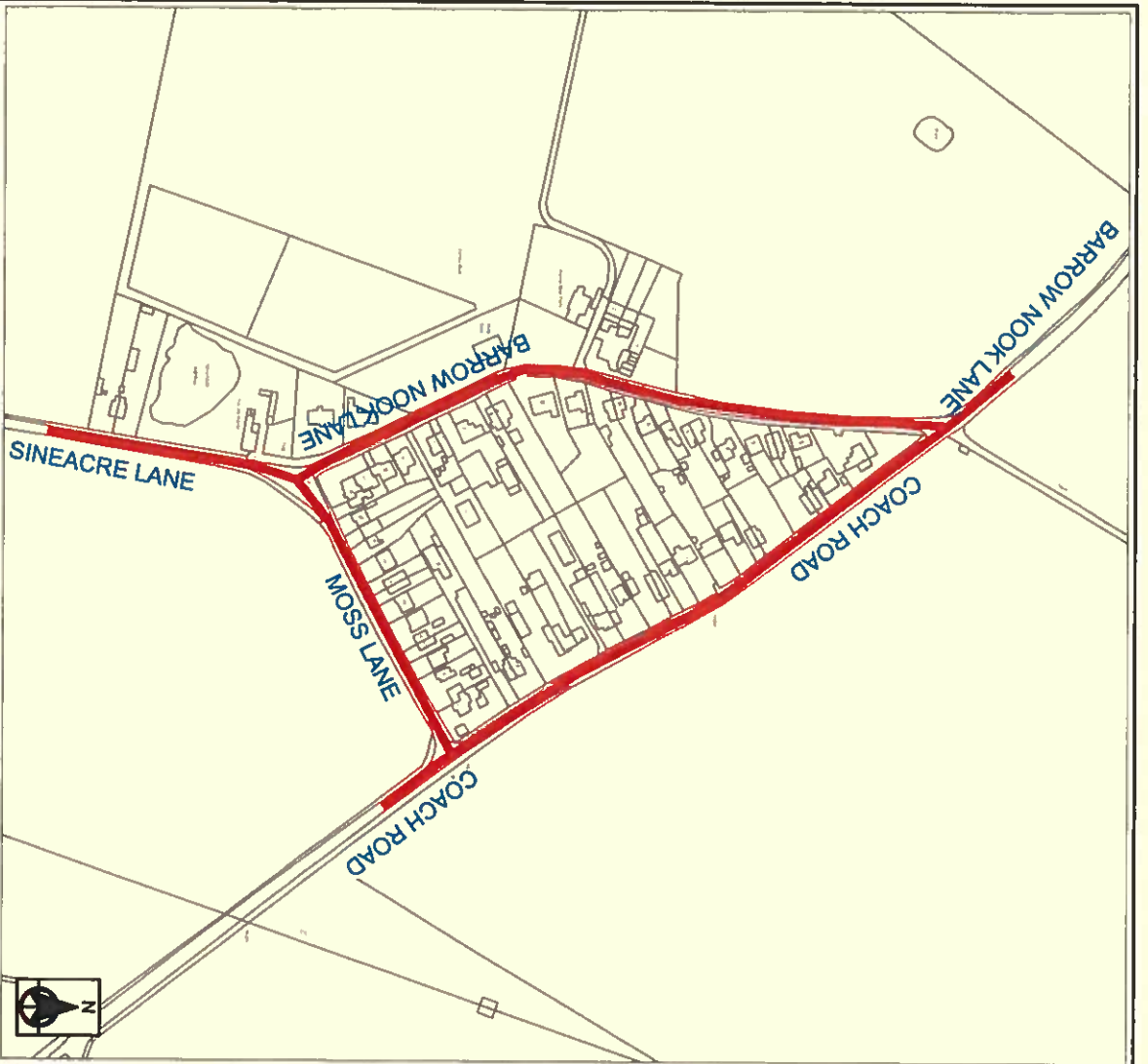

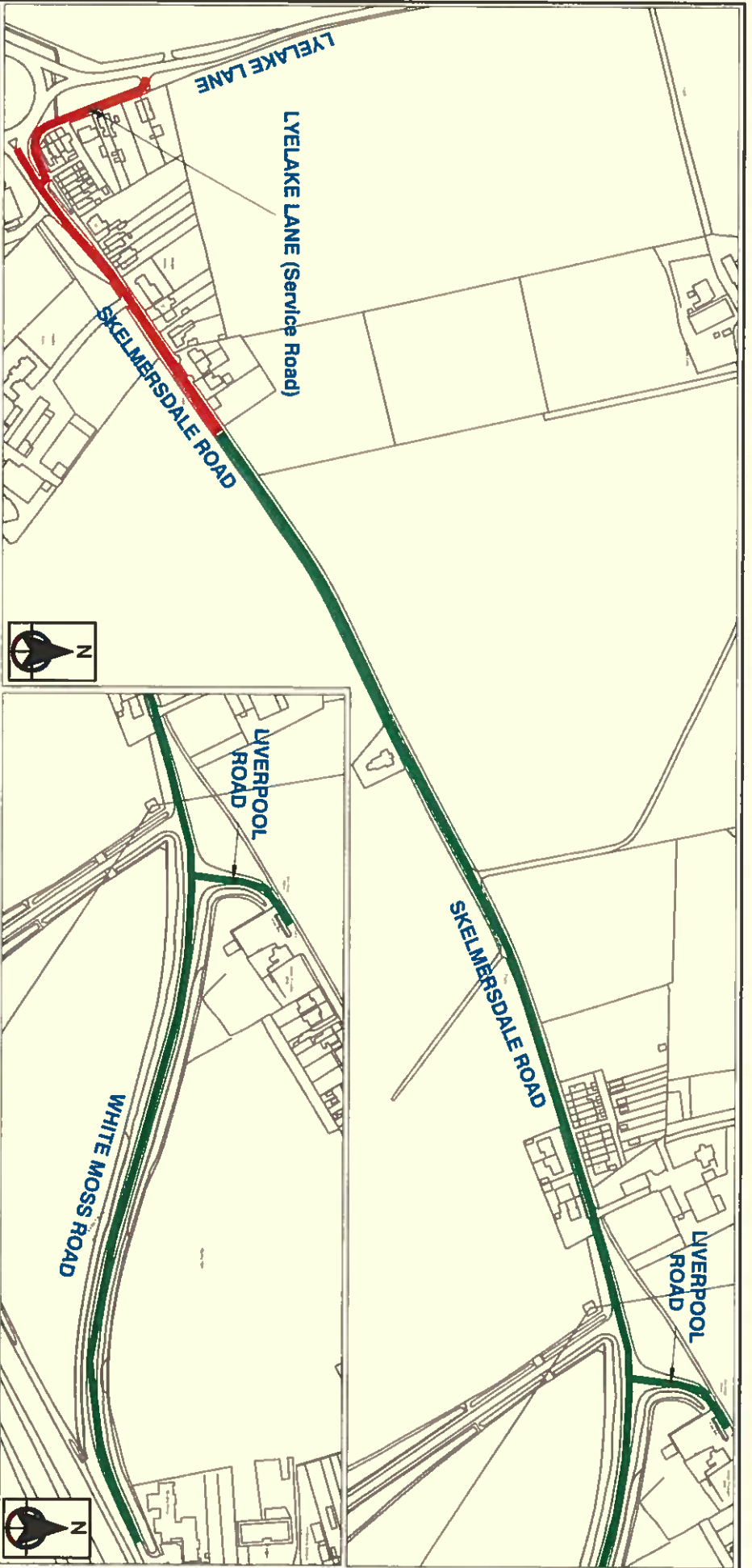

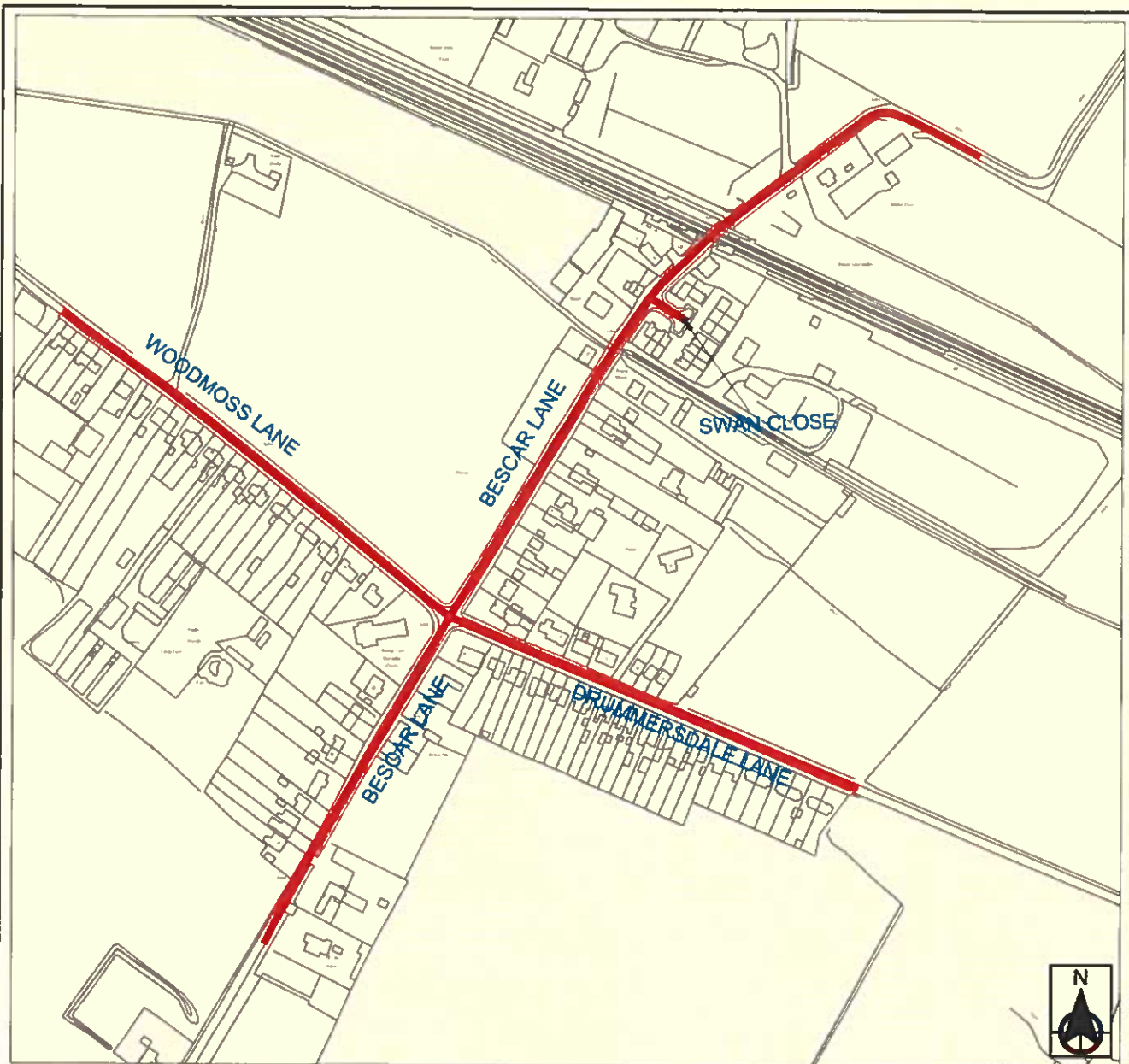

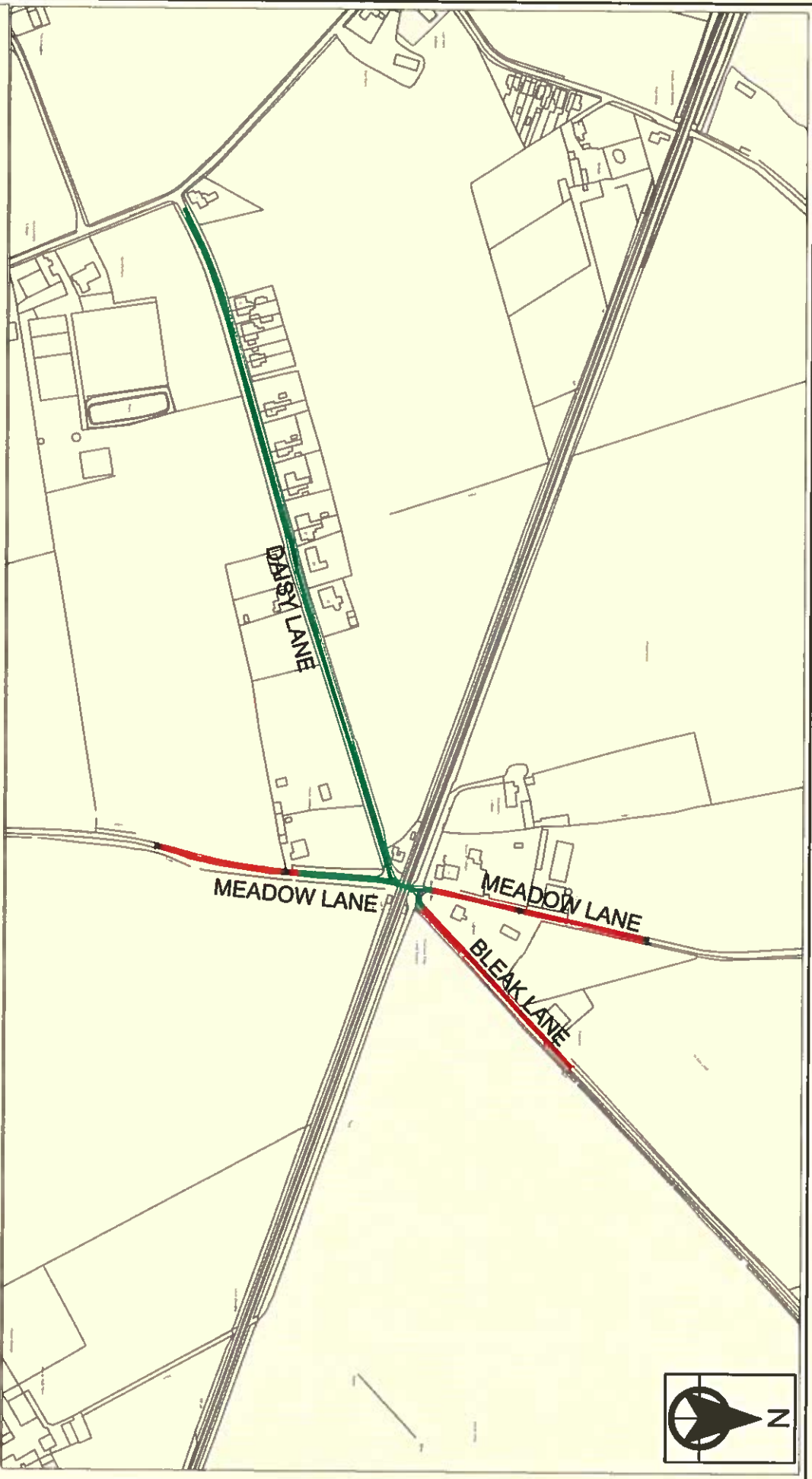

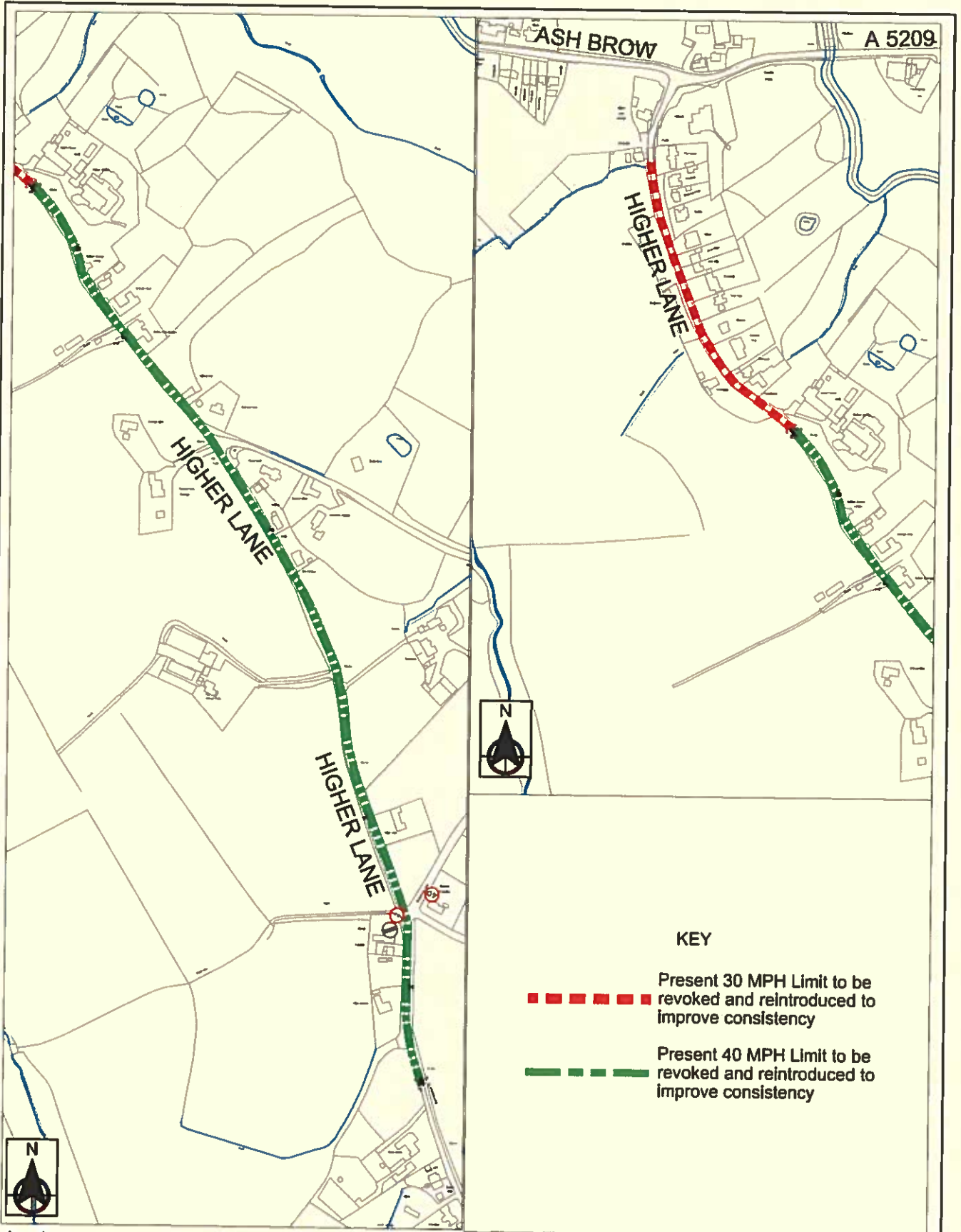
