

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COBBS BROW LANE, COBBS CLOUGH ROAD AND WHALLEYS ROAD, SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (RESTRICTED ROAD, 30MPH AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2013

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1)(a) and (2) of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** as amended ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Restricted Roads

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road which shall become Restricted Roads (as defined in section 82 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984):

- i. **Whalleys Road, Skelmersdale**, from a point 40 metres south of the centre line of its junction with Cobbs Clough Road to the centre line of its junction with Cobbs Clough Road.
- ii. **Cobbs Clough Road, Skelmersdale**, from the centre line of its junction with Cobbs Brow Lane to the centre line of its junction with Whalleys Road to a point 100 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Whalleys Road, a total distance of 135 metres.

2. 30mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:

- i. **Cobbs Brow Lane, Skelmersdale**, from the centre line of its junction with Cobbs Clough Road to a point 55 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Beacon Lane;
- ii. **Cobbs Brow Lane, Skelmersdale**, from the centre line of its centre line junction with Cobbs Clough Road to a point 70 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Cobbs Clough Road.

3. 40mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along Cobbs Brow Lane, Skelmersdale, from a point 55 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Beacon Lane to a point 525 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Beacon Lane.

4. Exemption

No Speed Limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

5. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Cobbs Brow Lane, Cobbs Clough Road and Whalleys Road, Skelmersdale, West Lancashire Borough) (Restricted Road, 30mph And 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2013" and shall come into force on the 11th day of February 2013.



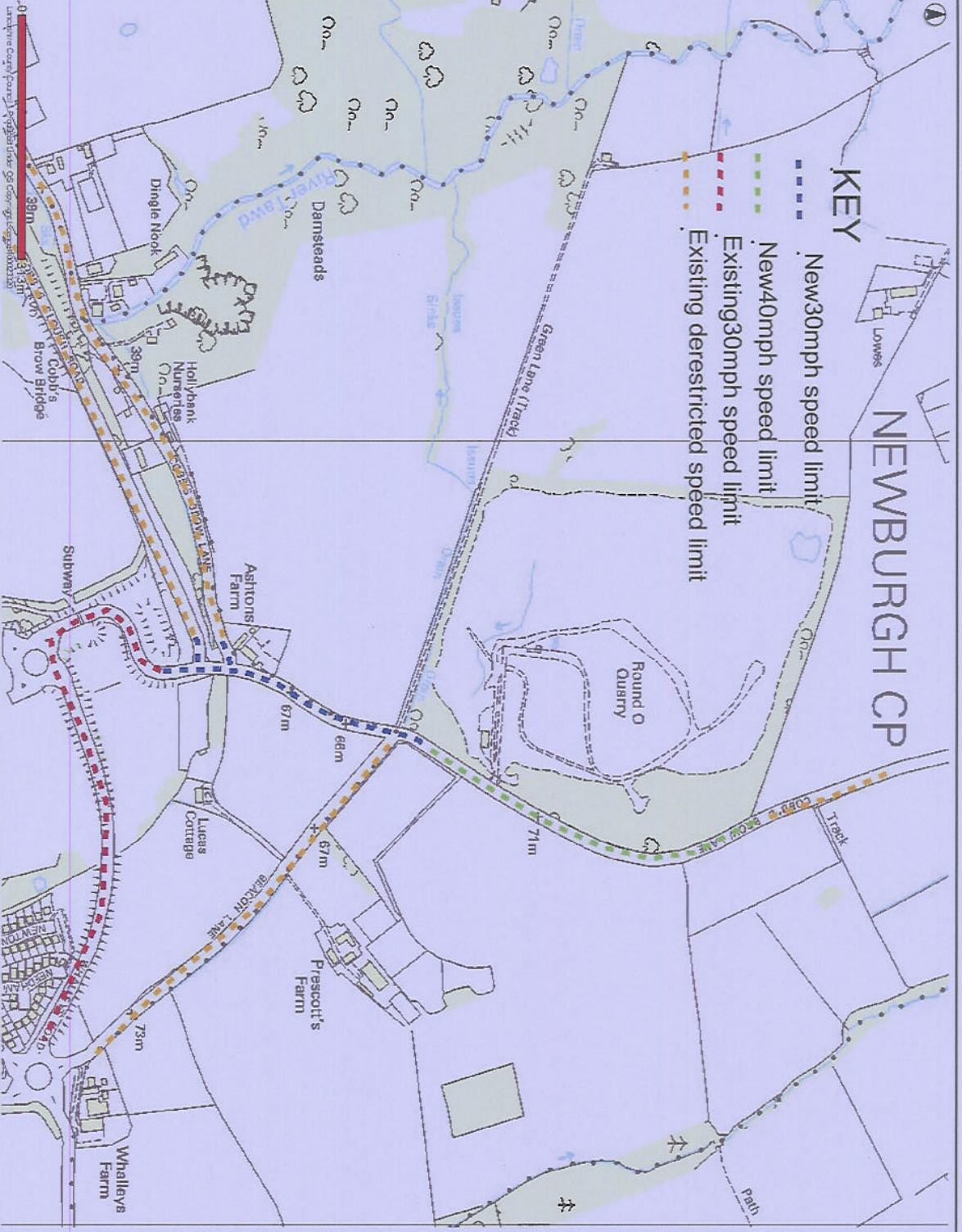
