**(VARIOUS LOCATIONS, PENDLE BOROUGH) (REVOCATION OF RESTRICTED ROADS) ORDER
202***

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Speed Limit Order under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to revoke the following:

- a) "The Lancashire County Council (Greenhead Lane, Reedley Hallows, Pendle Borough) (Restricted Road) Order 1994" in full;
- b) Schedule 2 of the "Lancashire County Council (Barrowford Road, Burnley and Pendle Boroughs) (Revocation, 30, 40 and 50 mph Speed Limits) Order 2012";
- c) "The Borough of Pendle (Whitewalls Drive, Colne) (Restricted Road) Order, 2003" insofar as it relates to the 30mph Speed Restriction (Restricted Road) on Whitewalls Drive, from the point of the existing 30mph limit to a point 70 metres in a north westerly direction.

Where no further speed limit is re-introduced, the speed limit will revert to restricted road status by virtue of street lighting, where a 30mph speed limit will apply.
