6. Havana Nickson's Lane  
South West Phase A

my property is Havana on  
Nickson's Lane. My garden is  
around 180m from the Phase I  
excavation area. At the moment my  
garden area is effectively silent.  
There is no traffic noise, only  
bird song and bees rustling  
in the wind. We are occasionally  
disturbed by dogs barking at  
Red Lea kennels. The kennels  
are around 380m away.

Regardless of calculated  
noise levels, to suggest that an  
excavator working at less than  
half the distance to the  
kennels would have no  
significant adverse impact  
on the noise levels in our  
garden is clearly absolute  
nonsense. The quarry should  
not be allowed.

## ⑦ (Gas and) water mains.

Water mains haven't been discussed. These are shown as a blue dotted line on the map. Residents on Gaulters Lane ~~whose properties~~ have deeds showing the water mains potentially running inside the site line and under bunds at phase 3B.
