

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(BLACKBURN ROAD, BURNLEY ROAD AND MARKET STREET, EDENFIELD, ROSSENDALE**  
**BOROUGH) (REVOCAION, PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND STOPPING ON SCHOOL KEEP**  
**CLEAR MARKINGS) ORDER 202\***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the following:
  - a) The "Lancashire County Council (Rossendale Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to:
    - i. Items (14)b), (83)b)(i) and (83)b)(ii) of Schedule 10.01;
    - ii. Item (48) of Schedule 11.075.
  - b) The "Lancashire County Council (Market Street and Pilgrim Gardens, Edenfield, Rossendale Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2020" insofar as it relates to Item a) of The Schedule;
  - c) The "Lancashire County Council (Rossendale Borough Area) (No Waiting At Any Time) Order 2012" insofar as it relates to Items (8)(i), (8)(ii) and (11) of The Schedule;
  - d) The "Lancashire County Council (Rossendale Borough Area) (Prohibition of Stopping On School Entrance Markings) Order 2011" insofar as it relates to Item (7) of The Schedule.
2. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:
  - a) Access Road To Car Park Situated Opposite 1-5 Spring Bank on Burnley Road, Edenfield, Bury, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Burnley Road for a distance of 13 metres in an easterly direction;
  - b) Blackburn Road, Edenfield, Bury, the west side, from a point 70.2 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Esk Avenue to its centreline junction with Market Street;
  - c) Burnley Road, Edenfield, Bury, the east side, from its junction with the centreline of Guide Court for a distance of 116 metres in a northerly direction;
  - d) Market Street, Edenfield, Bury, the east side, from its junction with the centreline of Guide Court for a distance of 4.5 metres in a southerly direction;
  - e) Market Street, Edenfield, Bury, the east side, from a point 11.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Church Lane to its junction with the centreline of East Street;
  - f) Market Street, Edenfield, Bury, the west side, from its centreline junction with Market Street to a point 5 metres south of its junction with the centreline of East Street;
  - g) Market Street, Edenfield, Bury, the west side, from a point 24 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Pilgrim Gardens for a distance of 134 metres in a northerly direction;
  - h) Teg Road, Edenfield, Bury, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Blackburn Road for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction;
  - i) Valley View Drive, Edenfield, Bury, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Market Street for a distance of 18 metres in a westerly direction.
3. Introduce a prohibition of stopping on school keep clear markings Monday to Friday between 8am and 6pm in Market Street, Edenfield, Bury, the east side, from a point 4.5 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Guide Court for a distance of 37.56 metres in a southerly direction.
