(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION ON WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this order.

1. To temporarily prohibit waiting, loading and unloading at any time on the following lengths of highway laid out in the no waiting, loading and unloading schedule to this order.
2. The prohibitions will be operative from 0001 hours on Monday 18th May 2026 until 2359 on Friday 28th August 2026.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to anyone undertaking operations as part of the event.

Any prohibitions may be removed before its stated end time if deemed safe and appropriate by the event holder.

The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to enable the safe holding of the AIG Womens Open 2026.

Road Name	Side of Road	Length Affected
Beauclerk Road, Lytham St Annes	Both sides	(i) From a point 60 metres north west of its junction with Lindsay Avenue for a distance of 65 metres in a north westerly direction (ii) From its junction with Lima Road for a distance of 80 metres in an easterly direction (iii) From a point 20 metres north west of its junction with Lindsay Avenue for a distance of 40 metres in a south easterly direction
Lima Road, Lytham St Annes	Both sides	From its junction with Beauclerk Road for a distance of 70 metres in a north easterly direction
Links Gate, Lytham St Annes	(i) North westerly (ii) South easterly	(i) from a point 140 metres north east of its junction with St Patricks Road South for a distance of 40 metres in a north westerly direction (ii) from a point 130 metres north west of its junction with St Patricks Road South for a distance of 55 metres in a north westerly direction
Lindsay Avenue, Lytham St Annes	Both sides	From its junction with Beauclerk Road for a distance of 35 metres in a north easterly direction
