

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(MANCHESTER ROAD AREA, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(REVOCAION AND VARIOUS PARKING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER
202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 13th February 2026 and 13th March 2026, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Pendle Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to:
 - a) Item (211)c)(iii) of Schedule 10.01;
 - b) Item (9)(i) of Schedule 11.007.
2. Remove the prohibition of waiting in Albert Street, Nelson, the north east side, from its junction with the centreline of Manchester Road to its junction with the centreline of Rear 56 to 66 Manchester Road.
3. Remove the prohibition of loading and unloading in Albert Street, Nelson, the north east side, from its junction with Manchester Road (A682) for a distance of 25 metres in a north westerly direction.
4. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Albert Street, Nelson, the north east side, from its junction with the centreline of Manchester Road for a distance of 21.5 metres in a north westerly direction;
 - b) Manchester Road, Nelson, the north west side, from a point 16 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Macleod Street for a distance of 22 metres in a north easterly direction.
5. Introduce a prohibition of loading and unloading in Albert Street, Nelson, the north east side, from its junction with Manchester Road (A682) for a distance of 21.5 metres in a north westerly direction.
6. Introduce a restriction of waiting between 8am and 6pm in Manchester Road, Nelson, the north west side, from its junction with the Centreline of Victoria Street to a point 16 metres south west of its junction with the Centreline of Macleod Street.
7. Introduce a limited waiting parking place for 30 minutes with no return within 1 hour Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm in Albert Street, Nelson, the north east side, from a point 21.5 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Manchester Road for a distance of 5 metres in a north westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this scheme is to support the improved amenity in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson.

Following formal consultation and in response to feedback received it is proposed to make a modification to the original proposal by retaining a 5 metre length of limited waiting 30 minutes no return within 1 hour Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm on the north east side of Albert Street, Nelson. Subsequently, the originally proposed No Waiting and Loading At Any Time adjacent to the bay, has been reduced in length.

This modification also amends the existing Traffic Regulation Order to match the current road markings on site along Manchester Road and at its junction with Macleod Street. These were mistakenly omitted from the original proposal and will allow for effective enforcement.
