

**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(B6430 GARSTANG ROAD/PRESTON-LANCASTER OLD ROAD, CATTERALL, WYRE BOROUGH)
(REVOCATION AND RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER, 1998.**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The County Council of Lancaster (40mph Speed Limit) (No 2) Order, 1968, is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (B6430 Garstang Road/Preston-Lancaster Old Road, Catterall, Wyre Borough) (Revocation and Restricted Road) Order, 1998 and shall come into force on the 16th November, 1998.

SCHEDULE

B6430 Garstang Road/Preston-Lancaster Old Road, from a point 60 metres south of its junction with Calderhouse Lane in a southerly direction to its junction with the A6 Preston-Lancaster New Road, a distance of approximately 1700 metres.
