ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1960

The County Council of Lancashire (Restricted Roads)  
(No. 1) Order, 1964

The County Council for the County Palatine of Lancaster in exercise of their powers under section 20(3) and section 21(1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1960 after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County Palatine of Lancaster and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order and direct as follows:-

1. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 19 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order may be cited as "The County Council of Lancashire (Restricted Roads)(No. 1) Order, 1964" and shall come into operation on the twentieth day of February, 1964.

SCHEDULE

That length of Longridge Road, Chipping which extends from a point 240 yards south-east of its junction with Inglewhite Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 153 yards.
