THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967  
(RESTRICTED ROADS)(NO. 3) ORDER 1984

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, and of all other powers them enabling, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby Order as follows:-

1. It is directed that the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become restricted for the purpose of Section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended.
2. This Order shall be cited as the Lancashire County Council (Restricted Roads) (No. 3) Order 1984, and shall come into operation on the 6th April, 1984.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of roads at Bilborrow, in the Borough of Wyre

- (i) (C.350) Bilborrow Lane - From its junction with the A.6 Garstang Road in an easterly direction to a point 81 metres west of the centre line of the M.6 Motorway (a distance of 785 metres) and also to include the service road opposite Ash Grove, and the cul de sac servicing Holland and Arnold Villas.
- (ii) The whole length of the unclassified roads; Sycamore Road, The Grove and Beech Avenue.
- (iii) (Private Road) Myerscough Hall Drive - From its junction with the A.6 Preston - Lancaster Road in a westerly direction to the boundary of 'Inglewood' and 'Hollinwood', a distance of 145 metres.
