ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967  
THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER  
(RESTRICTED ROADS)(NO. 1) ORDER 1973

The County Council of the County Palatine of Lancaster in exercise of their powers under sections 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County Palatine of Lancaster hereby order as follows:-

1. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purpose of section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order may be cited as the County Council of Lancaster (Restricted Roads)(No. 1) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on the twenty-second day of January, 1973.

SCHEDULE

Length of road in the Parish of Billington in the Rural District of Blackburn

That length of Whalley Old Road (Class III) which extends from a point 338 metres (370 yards) south-west of its junction with Whalley New Road (A.59) in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 87 metres (95 yards).
