**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PADIHAM ROAD, SABDEN, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH)
(RESTRICTED ROAD) AND (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1996.**

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Road Traffic Act, 1934, Sec. 1 - Road Traffic Act, 1958, Sec 4, 30mph Speed Limit Order, insofar as it relates to the length of Padiham Road from a point 80 yards (73 metres) north east of Top Row to a point 50 yards (46 metres) east of Simonstone Road is hereby revoked.
2. The length of road specified in the schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Padiham Road Sabden, Ribble Valley Borough) (Restricted Road) and (Revocation) Order 1996 and shall come into force on the 22nd January, 1996.

THE COMMON SEAL of the Lancashire County Council was hereunto affixed in pursuance of a Resolution passed at a meeting of the Highways and Transportation Committee duly convened and held on the 2nd November, 1994.

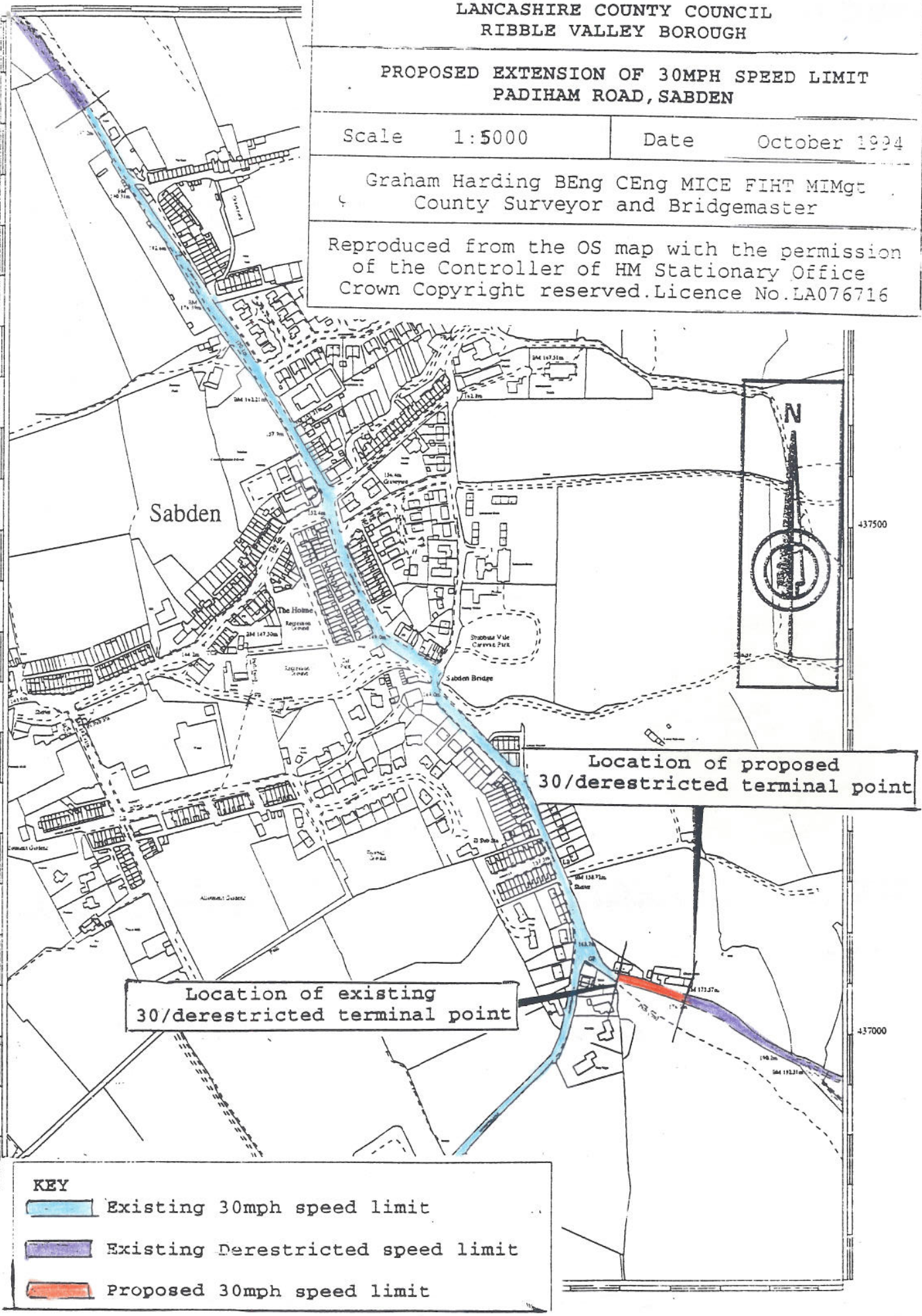
PROPOSED EXTENSION OF 30MPH SPEED LIMIT
