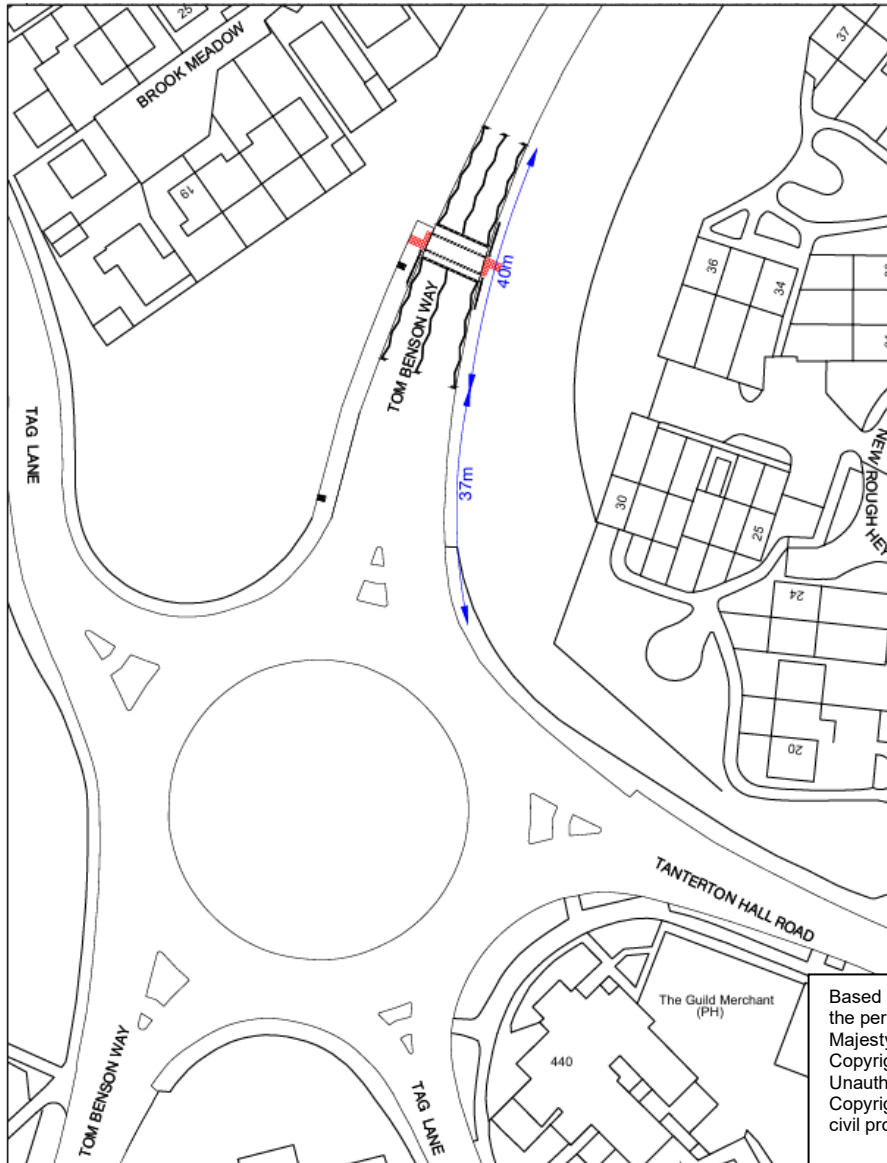


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(TOM BENSON WAY, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a toucan crossing in Tom Benson Way (B6241), Preston, from a point 37 metres north of its roundabout junction with Tom Benson Way (B5411) for a distance of 40 metres in a northerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The proposals are being pursued as part of a Section 278 agreement under the Highways Act 1980. These proposals are being funded fully by the developer and are linked to the new housing development on Lightfoot Lane and associated planning conditions.

The purpose of the proposed Toucan crossings is to provide safe crossing point for cyclist and pedestrians to promote sustainable travel and promote social inclusion. The proposal seeks to mitigate against the increase in traffic and pedestrian movements generated by the new development.
