

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(GARSTANG ROAD, PILLING, WYRE BOROUGH) (RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 2001**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1. Restricted Road**


The length of Garstang Road Pilling for a distance of 690 metres in an easterly direction from a point 323 metres west of the centreline of Horse Park Lane, shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

**2. Commencement of Order**

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Garstang Road, Pilling, Wyre Borough) (Restricted Road) Order 2001" and shall come into force on the 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2001.
