(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Ashfield Road, Burnley for 20 metres in either direction of the Railway Bridge.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0940 hours on Thursday 7th May 2026 until 2359 hours on Monday 11th May or until completion of the works within this period
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the tipper wagons in and out of the site for the removal of fly tipping spoil works to be carried out by Centurion Traffic Management on behalf of Network Rail
