


LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(GRIMSHAW ROAD, SKELMERSDALE,
WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Grimshaw Road, Skelmersdale from westbound slip road at the junction with Tanhouse Road for a distance of 174 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0900 to 1500 hours on Wednesday 10th June to Friday 12th June 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Works are weather dependent and may not be carried out on the dates specified. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
B5312 Grimshaw Road, Tanhouse Road, Digmoor Road, Gillibrands Road, Whiteledge Road, B5312 Grimshaw Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out.
