(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lancaster Avenue and Gloucester Avenue, Accrington for the full length.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 to 1500 hours on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pre-surface dressing patching works carried out by Lancashire County Council.
