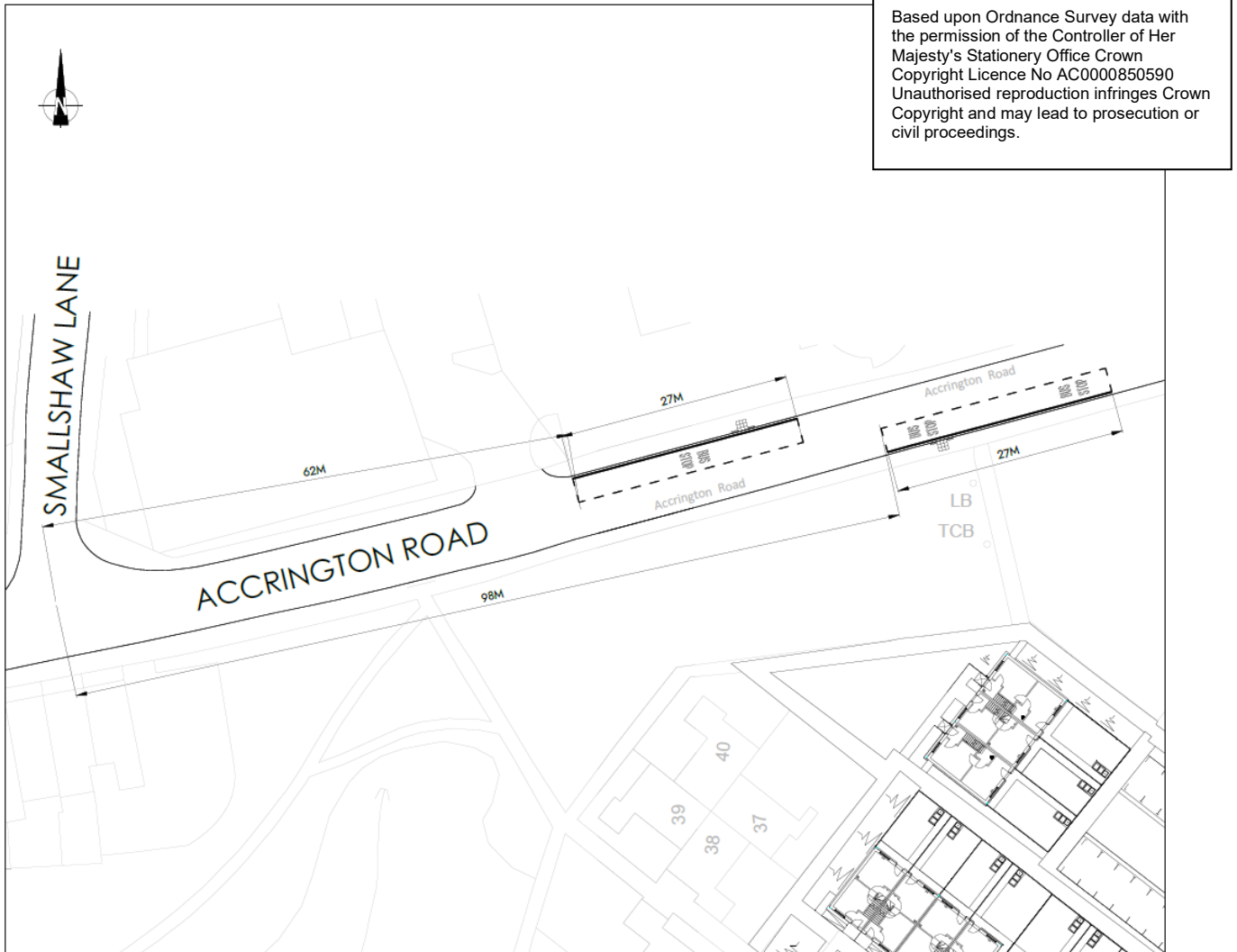


**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(ACCRINGTON ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (BUS STOP CLEARWAY)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:

- a) Accrington Road, Burnley, the north side, from a point 62 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Smallshaw Lane for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly direction;
- b) Accrington Road, Burnley, the south side, from a point 98 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Smallshaw Lane for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly direction.



**Statement of Reasons**

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stop on Accrington Road Burnley, with enforceable clearway markings and signs allowing buses to pull in safely and efficiently at the stop.

The proposal intends to promote sustainable transport for all users by including the construction of a raised platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
