(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Penketh Place, West Pimbo, Up Holland at its junction with Pimbo Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from the following times.
 - a. 1900 hours on Tuesday 23rd June until 0400 hours on Wednesday 24th June 2026
 - b. 1900 hours on Wednesday 24th June until 0400 hours on Thursday 25th June 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Due to the nature of the works, there will be no access for emergency services.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. There is not an alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure as Penketh Place is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out to install and joint new cables.
